RESOLUTION 2012-110-A

A RESOLUTION CELEBRATING THE 450TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE LANDING OF JEAN RIBAULT IN THE NEW WORLD; COMMEMORATING THE **EVENTS** THAT LED ESTABLISHMENT OF THE FIRST EUROPEAN COLONY OF MEN AND ESTABLISHED FOR THE PURPOSE RELIGIOUS FREEDOM; DESIGNATING MAY 1, 2012 AS JEAN RIBAULT DAY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Jean Ribault, a renowned French navigator and sea captain, led the voyage from France to form a colony in the New World; and

WHEREAS, on May 1, 1562, Ribault and his oarsmen landed on the banks of the majestic river which he named the River May and which we now know as the St. Johns River where he and his crew uttered the first Protestant prayers in the New World; and

WHEREAS, upon offering a prayer of thanksgiving for their safe arrival, Ribault developed friendships with the Mocama-speaking natives; and

WHEREAS, on May 2, 1562, Ribault and his men erected a column in honor of their King, Charles IX, thereby claiming the land for France; and

WHEREAS, Jacksonville shares a Sister City relationship with Nantes, France, where in 1598 King Henry IV issued the Edict of Nantes which granted the Calvinist Protestants (also known as Huguenots) substantial civil and economic rights in the predominantly Roman Catholic kingdom, thus ending the "Wars of

Religion" that bedeviled France in the first half of the 16th century and promoting a more tolerant and inclusive society; and WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville desires to celebrate with our sister city Nantes the events leading to the establishment of the first European colony in America; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Celebration. The City of Jacksonville hereby celebrates the $450^{\rm th}$ Anniversary of the landing of Jean Ribault on the banks of the St. Johns River.

Commemoration. The City of Jacksonville does Section 2. hereby join with its sister city, Nantes, France, in commemorating the events that led to the establishment of the first European Colony of men and women established in America for the purpose of religious freedom.

Section 3. Designation. The Council does hereby designate May 1, 2012 as Jean Ribault Day in Jacksonville.

Section 4. Effective Date: This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
