CHAPTER 95-530

House Bill No. 2735

An act relating to the City of Jacksonville; amending s. 23.07 of art. 23 of chapter 92-341, Laws of Florida, being the charter of the City of Jacksonville; authorizing and approving the settlement of certain litigation relating to art. 23 of the charter of the City of Jacksonville providing for an offsite commercial billboard ban; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (e) is added to section 23.07 of article 23 of chapter 92-341, Laws of Florida, to read:

Section 23.07. Council's power and right to legislate.—This article shall not affect the council's power and right to legislate with respect to:

(e) Any settlement of litigation commenced prior to January 1, 1995, to enforce or interpret this article.

Section 2. Settlements made and approved by the City of Jacksonville prior to the effective date of this act of any litigation commenced prior to January 1, 1995, to interpret or enforce article 23 of the charter are hereby approved, ratified, and confirmed.

Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

Became a law without the Governor's approval June 18, 1995.
