An act relating to the City of Jacksonville, Duval County; amending chapter 92-341, Laws of Florida, as amended; amending the Charter of the City of Jacksonville; clarifying the exemptions provided by the charter to designated employees; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsections (k), (l), (t), (u), and (aa) of section 17.06 of Article 17 of chapter 92-341, Laws of Florida, as amended, are amended, and subsection (gg) is added to said section, to read:

## ARTICLE 17. CIVIL SERVICE

Section 17.06. Applicability of civil service system to employees of consolidated government.—The civil service provisions of this charter shall be applicable to all employees of the consolidated government except:

(k) Assistant council auditor, council secretary, council assistant secretaries, the secretary to the president of the council, the council director of staff services, chief of research, senior research associate, the council research assistants, and the chief of council administration, and executive council assistants appointed by council members, upon-approval-of-the-City-Council, council-aids, provided-that any-person-holding-the-position-fo-council-aid-on-July-1, 1996, and who-previous-to-that-date-had-civil-service-status, shall-retain-protection-from-dismissal-without-cause-as provided-in-the-civil-service-and-personnel-rules-and
