CHAPTER 98-468

House Bill No. 3651

An act relating to Duval County; providing that specified general law supersedes special acts applicable to Duval County with respect to school district personnel; providing for certain employees to retain rights under special acts; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Notwithstanding any special act that applies to Duval County, sections 231.29 and 231.36, Florida Statutes, as amended by chapter 97-310, Laws of Florida, apply to school district personnel in Duval County; however, persons employed continuously by the district school board of Duval County before July 1, 1998, may retain all rights that they have under chapter 21197, Laws of Florida, 1941, as amended.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 1998.

Became a law without the Governor's approval May 28, 1998.
