# **How to Read This Schedule**

Not every trolley stop is listed on the schedule. The stops listed across the top are called time points, which are used to keep the trolley on schedule.

Locate your starting point on the map. Find the nearest trolley stop (indicated by a dot), as well as the nearest time point after your stop (indicated by a letter in a circle). On the schedule, look in the column below that time point to find the time closest to when you want to get on the trolley. Make sure you look at the schedule that corresponds to the direction you are going. Estimate the time it will take the trolley to get from your starting point to that time point, and be at your stop at least five minutes prior to that time. Read the schedule from left to right to find the time the trolley will arrive at other time points.









# The Riverside Trolley is a year-round service providing transportation between Downtown and Riverside.

#### **Route**

The route covers approximately five miles between Downtown and FSCJ Kent Campus with stops at the Jacksonville Landing, Riverside Park, Five Points, Memorial Park, St. Vincent's Medical Center, The Shoppes of Avondale and FSCI Kent Campus among others.

### **Fare**

The regular fare is \$1 per trip. Individuals with disabilities can show a valid reduced fare card from any transit agency or a valid Medicare card to receive a reduced rate. Passengers who are 60 and older ride free upon presentation of a valid, government-issued picture ID showing their birthdate, such as a driver license, state ID card or transit system ID card.
