MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AMENDMENT NO. 1

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the CITY and DCSB have previously entered into a Joint Use Agreement dated January 20, 1998 as amended from time to time (the "Agreement") allowing the CITY and DCSB to jointly use certain DCSB property and certain CITY property more particularly described herein for recreational and educational purposes in accordance with said Agreement and the limitations set forth therein;

WHEREAS, the Agreement requires the parties to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding for each DCSB property and CITY property that is subject to the Agreement, setting forth in detail the extent of the use to be made of each property;

WHEREAS, the CITY and DCSB entered into two previous Memoranda of Understanding ("Memoranda") dated August 12, 1999 and January 22, 2002 for the Joint Use of a portion of the DCSB land at Hogan Spring Glen Elementary School No. 64;

WHEREAS, the CITY and DCSB desire to amend the Memorandum to allow the CITY to construct additional improvements on the "Property" hereafter described, and to set forth the terms and conditions necessary by the parties to ensure the jointly used property is well maintained and operated;

WHEREAS, this Memorandum of Understanding amends the previous memorandum dated January 22, 2002 and provides for all requirements of the CITY and DCSB for the Property hereafter described:

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 5.B. of the Agreement, the CITY and DCSB have authorized the Director, Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services for the CITY and the Assistant Superintendent, Operations, for DCSB, to execute all Memoranda of Understanding and amendments thereto, on behalf of the CITY and DCSB, respectively;

NOW THEREFORE, the parties in consideration of the foregoing and the mutual promises and covenants herein, agree as follows:

Section 1. <u>Use.</u> The CITY shall have the right to use jointly with DCSB the area designated on the plat diagram or site plan attached hereto as <u>Exhibit A</u> and made a part hereof (the

- "Property") at <u>HOGAN SPRING GLEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL NO. 64</u> for educational and recreational purposes only. The CITY shall have the right to use the Property for the purposes stated herein, at the times set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto and made a part hereof.
- Section 2. <u>Improvements.</u> The CITY has previously installed improvements listed on <u>Exhibit B</u>, and may install additional improvements as listed on <u>Exhibits C-1 through C-4</u>; attached hereto and made part hereof (the "Improvements"). All Improvements shall meet Florida Department of Education safety standards, Florida Building Code, and all other applicable state and local codes and ordinances.
- Section 3. <u>Maintenance of Improvements and Property.</u> CITY shall maintain, at its sole cost and expense, all improvements installed by the CITY on the Property. CITY will maintain any and all drainage improvements and drainage modifications made by CITY to the Property, and will insure there are no impacts to the neighboring adjacent properties. CITY will repair and re-pave the existing asphalt entry and exit drives from the school entrance off Beach Blvd to the park entrance.
- Section 4. <u>Title of Improvements</u>. At the termination of this Memorandum of Understanding DCSB, at its option, may keep any or all of the Improvements installed by CITY on the Property and the CITY shall convey its rights, title and interest in the Improvements "as is" with no warranties as to merchantability or fitness to the DCSB or DCSB may require the CITY to demolish and remove the Improvements on the Property and return the Property completely as practicable to its original condition prior to the installations of the Improvements.
- Section 5. <u>Memorandum Period and Termination.</u> This Memorandum shall be effective as of the Effective Date and shall continue unless terminated by either party, with or without cause, upon giving three (3) months written notice to the other party.
- Section 6. <u>Notices.</u> All notices required under this Memorandum shall be made in writing and served upon CITY by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to Director, Department of Parks, Recreation and Community Services, 214 N. Hogan Street, Jacksonville Florida 32202, and served upon DCSB by registered or certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to Assistant Superintendent, Operations, 1701 Prudential Drive, Jacksonville, FL 32207-8181 with a copy to the Principal, <u>Hogan Spring Glen Elementary School No. 64</u> at 6736 Beach Boulevard, Jacksonville, Florida 32216.
- Section 7. <u>Amendments.</u> This Memorandum may be amended from time to time by written request and agreement of the parties. The Director, Parks, Recreation and Community Services, and the Assistant Superintendent, Operations, are authorized to execute any and all such amendments on behalf of the CITY and DCSB, respectively.
- Section 8. Association Use of Property. The CITY may allow associations, groups or individuals use of the Property for public purposes upon written agreement between CITY and the association, group or individual, in accordance with the terms and conditions of the Joint Use Agreement. Any such written agreement between the CITY and the association, group or individuals must be approved by the school principal, or his/her designee and the Assistant Superintendent, Operations. The DCSB may in its sole discretion deny such use.
- Section 9. <u>Utilities.</u> The CITY shall be responsible for the installation of required electrical, water and sewer service listed or required by any improvements made by the CITY. The

CITY shall be responsible for the payment of any utilities listed or required by the CITY's use of the site including but not limited to electrical, water, sewer and irrigation.

Section 10. <u>Signatures</u>. The parties agree that this Memorandum may be executed via counterpart and facsimile signatures, the counterparts and facsimiles of which, when taken together, shall be deemed to constitute an entire and original Memorandum.






EXHIBIT C-3 PROPERTY




EXHIBIT C-4 PROPERTY
