# FOURTH AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS FOURTH AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made and entered into as of this First day of October, 2016 ("Effective Date") by and between the City of Jacksonville, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "CITY" and the Florida Cooperative Extension Service, a division of the Institute of Food and Agricultural Sciences of the University of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "University".

#### WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the CITY and UNIVERSITY have entered into a Memorandum of Understanding dated July 1, 1983, providing for the operation of, and responsibilities relating to, the Duval County Extension program ("MOU"); and

WHEREAS, the CITY and UNIVERSITY have entered into a First Amendment dated March 1, 2007, to establish their respective responsibilities, including funding, and administrative rules regulating the Duval County IFAS Cooperative Extension Service; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and UNIVERSITY have entered into a Second Amendment dated March 1, 2010, to expand their respective responsibilities to funding by providing for existing and future residual funding and administrative rules regulating the utilization of these funds by Duval County IFAS Cooperative Extension Service as provided herein; and

WHEREAS, the CITY and UNIVERSITY have entered into a Third Amendment dated October 1, 2011, to amend the MOU to continue with the terms and provisions of the MOU through September 30, 2016;

WHEREAS, the CITY and UNIVERSITY now desire to amend the MOU to include IT language and to also continue with the terms and provisions of the MOU through September 30, 2021;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises set forth herein, the parties hereby agree as follows:

#### RESPONSIBILITIES

II.C.4. COUNTY will coordinate computer network access with UNIVERSITY to ensure that all Extension Faculty and staff have access to UNIVERSITY computer network resources. County will allow the installation and use of client software and unrestricted access to online resources deemed necessary by UF Extension to conduct Extension business operations and program delivery. In an effort to mitigate the risks associated with such access from COUNTY's computer systems, UNIVERSITY will provide security management of such computer network resources for all those accessing such resources.

### PERIOD OF CONTRACT - RENEWAL - MODIFICATION

This Agreement shall be effective as of October 1° 2016 and shall continue through September 30th 2021, unless terminated earlier. At the time of expiration, this Agreement must then be updated as needed and resigned by both parties. The agreement may be modified at any time by mutual consent of both parties herein above. Additional funding is provided in attached Exhibit A.
