The Director of Parks Recreation & Entertainment is authorized to negotiate rental fees on an individual event basis, or on a series event not to exceed four event days within a 60-day period, based on a percentage of admission sales not to exceed 10% of total admission

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A. Metropolitan Park (Including the Metropolitan Park Pavilion)	\$4,000 or 10% per event, whichever is greater, or gross of any type admission fees received, after deduction of taxes, plus expenses
B. Metropolitan Park (Only)	\$2,500 or 10% per event, whichever is greater, of the gross of any type of admission fees received after deduction of taxes, plus expenses
C. Metropolitan Park Pavilion	\$1,500 or 10% per event, whichever is greater, of the gross of any type admission fees received, after deduction of taxes, plus expenses
