17 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 Section 1. All provisions of Article 7 of Chapter 67-1320,
19 Laws of Florida, being the Charter of the City of Jacksonville
20 relating to departments and divisions of the City are hereby
21 repealed except the provisions of Sections 7.102, 7.103, 7.104 and
22 7.303.

23 Section 2. Chapters 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20,
24 22, and 23 of the Ordinance Code of the City of Jacksonville are
25 amended, adopted and readopted to read as follows:

CHAPTER 23

OFFICE OF GENERAL COUNSEL

23.101 Office Established. There is established a department to be known as the Office of General Counsel, which shall have general responsibility for furnishing legal services to the City and its independent agencies, except where the Council may otherwise direct. For purposes of utilization of Central Services by the City and its independent agencies, the services of the Office of General Counsel shall be deemed to be central services, or services of the Central Services Department of the City, as the case may be. The head of the Office of General Counsel shall be the General Counsel. The General Counsel shall be an attorney licensed to practice law in the State of Florida and have at least five years' experience in the practice of law. He shall be appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the Council and shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

23.102 Assistant Counsel. The General Counsel shall appoint Assistant Counsel and fix their compensation, subject to approval of the Mayor. The General Counsel and all Assistant Counsel shall devote their entire time and attention to the business of the office and shall not engage in the private practice of law. No special counsel shall be employed by the City and paid from the public funds, unless otherwise provided for any independent agency, except that whenever, upon recommendation by the General Counsel, the interest of the City requires special counsel, the Council by resolution may employ such counsel, who shall be paid such compensation for their services as the General Counsel shall determine, and the Council shall approve, to be reasonable

1 compensation for the services to be rendered.

2 23.103 Corporation Secretary. Subject to applicable
3 civil service laws and rules, the General Counsel shall designate one
4 of his employees as Corporation Secretary.

5 23.104 Duties of Corporation Secretary. The Corporation
6 Secretary shall be responsible for the custody and safekeeping of
7 such records of the office of the Mayor as the Mayor shall designate
8 and for the performance of such additional duties as may be delegated
9 to him by the Mayor. The Corporation Secretary is authorized and
10 entitled to keep in his possession a duplicate official seal of the
11 City, and to affix the seal on all papers and documents necessary
12 to be executed by the Mayor and on all certified copies of public
13 records of which he has custody.

14 Section 3. This ordinance becomes effective upon signature
15 by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.


