Attorney Trisha Bowles advised the Board that the City of Jacksonville and the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office have been collaborating with the Hart Road Lodge, LLC's team, and the parties have reached an initial consensus. Through an agreement, they have stipulated the essential elements that are concerns of the Board and wish to proceed with remedial measures. They will return in person on May 25, 2023 to provide updates and discuss any additional recommendations and requirements made by the Board.

A motion was made to declare the Hart Road Lodge, LLC properly located at 10885 Harts Road a public nuisance based on their stipulation that the elements of sections 672.04 of the Jacksonville Municipal Code have been met, based on the more than 2 forcible felonies which occurred on the property within 6 months, by Board Member Randy Wishard and seconded by Board Member Alex Moye. Motion passed unanimously: 9:0.

A second motion was made to adopt the remedial measures of the stipulated agreement to abate the nuisance and require the respondent to appear at the May 25, 2023 meeting, to advise the Board of their progress towards those measures, to review the results of the CPTED report from JSO and to be subject to any other relief and measures deemed appropriate by the Board, by Vice Chair, Adam Edgecombe, Esq. and seconded by Board Member Richard Reichard.

Motion passed unanimously: 9:0.
