RISK MANAGEMENT DIVISION

The City of Jacksonville is self-insured and self-administered for Worker's Compensation Injuries.

Your accident must be reported to your supervisor or designated person in your division immediately so a First Report of Injury can be completed. In case of an emergency for an on the job accident, your supervisor or on-site lead worker will refer you to an authorized hospital or the closest emergency room. In the case of a non-emergency, you should visit one of the pre-approved initial treatment facilities <u>on the attached list</u>. Pursuant to the Workers' Compensation Statutes, Florida Statutes, 440.13(3)(a), your treatment may not be compensable if you obtain treatment from an unauthorized physician, regardless of the purpose for the treatment.

If you are injured at work, follow these simple steps:

- 1. Notify your manager/supervisor immediately of your injury and assist with the completion of the *First Report of Injury* form (DWC-1), whether or not you need medical care.
- 2. If you feel you need medical attention, please go to one of the medical providers listed below for your initial treatment. Please contact your worker's compensation claims adjuster regarding direction for supplemental care and authorized providers.
- 3. **ATTENTION SUPERVISOR:** Please complete Section One of the *Workers' Compensation Medical Report Form* and send with employee to medical provider.
