






Traditional Central Sewer





Problem Areas


- High Density of Septic Tanks
- Near impacted and distressed water bodies
- Not reachable using traditional methods




VOLUSIA BLUE, NITROGEN SOURCE LOADING



Integrated Sewer Network



Advantages



- Provides sewer service to any location
- A single DEP Permit authorizes a near-unlimited number of installations
- Treatment systems are operated by a licensed operator
- Ideal for nutrient BMAPs and eligible for FDEP septic-to-sewer funding
- Savings of \$7000 – \$20,000 per connection over traditional sewer retrofits
