- 6. Chairs Report: Vice- Chair Tyrona Clark- Murray informed the CPAC members that the Northwest CPAC FY2022-2026 Capital Improvement Program recommendations were submitted. Vice-Chair Tyrona Clark-Murray reminded the CPAC members that the purpose of the CPAC is to serve as the bridge between the City of Jacksonville and the communities in the Northwest District. She gave an overview of accomplishments the Northwest CPAC has made.

# 7. Subcommittee and Liaison Reports

- Land Use and Zoning Subcommittee: Vice-Chair Tyrona Clark- Murray reported that LUZ Subcommittee members reviewed four new Land Use and Zoning applications, and no motions were recommended.
- TRUE Commission: No Report
- Transportation: Vice-Chair Tyrona Clark- Murray reported, the North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) CAC met on Wednesday, June 2, 2021. She stated at a previous meeting Larry Solomon informed the NFTPO CAC that the bridge near US-1 and Richardson Road needs to be elevated due to flooding. The NFTPO Regional Manager was supposed to speak with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to conduct a study at the bridge but did not. The manager will give an update at the NFTPO CAC August meeting. Vice-Chair Tyrona Clark-Murray provided the CPAC members a brief overview of a presentation the Jacksonville International Airport gave at the NFTPO CAC meeting. The NFTPO CAC approved \$262,000 to install a solar system roof and to purchase additional electric buses at the Jacksonville Transportation Authority (JTA) Armsdale Park-n-Ride (3191 Armsdale Road).

- Jacksonville Sheriff's Office (JSO): Lt. John Gay reported that crimes in the Northwest District are low compared to last year. Lt. Gay informed the members on June 8, 2021, JSO hosted the One Congregation One Precinct (OneCOP) Luncheon. The purpose of the luncheon is to build relationships between JSO and the communities. Lt. Gay invited CPAC members to become a part of Zone 5 Sheriff's Watch. - Parks Johnnetta Moore, Chief of Social Services Division, reported the following:
  - o Senior Centers are scheduled to open on August 9, 2021.
  - The new playground at the Catherine Hester McNair Park, also known as Brentwood Park, is completed. Parks is currently working on a walkway replacement, no date completion date set.
  - The Northbank Riverwalk Floating Dock Project is scheduled for completion by the end of June 2021, except for the area in front of the Florida Times-Union where the bulkhead construction is underway.
  - The Friendship Park Fountain Project should be completed by Spring 2022, and the surrounding park Summer 2022.
  - o The Post Street Dock Project should be completed by Spring 2022.
  - o The Jackson Street Dock should be completed by Winter 2021.
  - o The Springfield Dog Park improvements will start in Fall 2021.
  - o The Warren W. Schell Jr. Memorial Park playground installation will start in Fall 2021.
