#### RESOLUTION JIA/CRA-2021-03 (as amended)

A RESOLUTION OF THE JACKSONVILLE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AIRPORT AGENCY ("JIA/CRA") AUTHORIZING A NEW CAPITAL PROJECT TO BE CALLED THE MAIN STREET WIDENING PROJECT; APPROVING \$23,000,000 IN TOTAL FUNDING OVER THREE FISCAL YEAR BUDGETS; ALLOCATING \$9,000,000 FROM THE FY 20/21 AMENDED AND RESTATED BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING FOR FUND CARRYOVER; **AUTHORIZING EXECUTION** OF ALL **DOCUMENTS** BY THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2021, the JIA/CRA Advisory Board, with a unanimous vote of 5-0, recommended to the JIA/CRA Agency Board (the "Agency Board") that \$15,000,000 be allocated over the next three years, in \$5,000,000 increments, to a new activity created for design and construction of the "Main Street Widening Project"; and

**WHEREAS,** there is \$9,974,703 remaining in the FY 20/21 Amended and Restated Budget line item "Unallocated Plan Authorized Expenditures"; and

WHEREAS, the Agency Board is empowered to authorize projects within the JIA/CRA Redevelopment Area that are consistent with and further the JIA/CRA Redevelopment Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Agency Board found that fully funding the Main Street Widening Project with \$23,000,000 (over three years) amount recommended by the Advisory Board would allow the project to be implemented in a more timely manner with the funding partners of the Florida Department of Transportation ("FDOT") and the Transportation Planning Organization ("TPO"), and would extend the project from New Berlin Road to the Max Leggett Parkway instead of just from New Berlin Road to Airport Center Drive; and

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with Sec. 106.341, *Ordinance Code*, the Agency Board has been given authority to allocate and transfer funds from "Unallocated Plan Authorized Expenditures" to a specific Plan Capital Project, such as the Main Street Widening Project, without further Council approval; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 126.211, Ordinance Code, the City may utilize a

competitively procured government contract "for the procurement of supplies, professional design services, professional services, contractual services and capital improvements by the City and its independent and/or using agencies;" now therefore

## **BE IT RESOLVED,** by the JIA/CRA:

Section 1. Authorization and Findings. The Agency Board approves and authorizes the development of a capital project to be known as the "Main Street Widening Project" and finds that it is within the JIA/CRA Redevelopment Area and in compliance with, and furthers the purposes and objectives of the JIA/CRA Redevelopment Plan as follows:

### 1. Page 5: Regarding Ports, Aviation, and Related Facilities –

Goal 5: An integrated system shall be developed which will stimulate the economic development of the community, maximize compatibility of transportation facilities with the surrounding community, maximize options for flexibility in the future expansion of the system, and minimize the environmental impact of these transportation systems.

### 2. Page 6: Regarding Traffic Circulation –

Goal 2: Increase Existing Transportation Network Capacity—The traffic-carrying ability of the existing roadway network shall be optimized and the traffic-carrying capacity of any capacity-deficient roadway segment shall be increased to the highest practical level of efficiency before considering the addition of through-lane miles.

### 3. Page 7: Regarding Traffic Circulation -

**Goal 3**: Increase Total Roadway Network – New lane miles shall be added to the existing roadway network when necessary to ensure the safe, efficient movement of persons and goods. The addition of lane miles will be accomplished where possible, within the existing roadways right-of-way.

- 4. Page 12: Regarding: Transportation in the San Mateo, Pecan Park and Oceanway neighborhoods
  - a) To lessen traffic congestion on major thoroughfares adjoining neighborhoods and the safety hazards connected with congestion.

### 5. Page 27: Regarding Proposed Circulation -

- c) Improvements to local circulation system by vacating or improving various streets within the area; and
  - d) Emphasis of major thoroughfares and their intersections to improve vehicular

movement within the area.

- **Section 2. Project Approval.** The Main Street Widening Project is hereby approved for a total amount of funding of \$23,000,000 over three (3) fiscal years in the following increments: \$9,000,000 in FY 20/21; \$7,000,000 in FY 21/22; and \$7,000,000 in FY 22/23.
- Section 3. Allocation. Pursuant to Sec. 106.341, *Ordinance* Code, the JIA/CRA hereby allocates and transfers \$9,000,000 from "Unallocated Plan Authorized Expenditures" within the Plan Authorized Expenditures Category of the FY 20/21 Amended and Restated Budget to a new activity created for the Main Street Widening Project, which project description is attached hereto as **Exhibit** A. Funding in future years will be pursuant to approval and allocation by the JIA/CRA, and the City Council through the annual budget process.
- Section 4. Revenue Transfer. Pursuant to Sec. 106.344, *Ordinance Code*, a CRA Budget Transfer Form and CRA Capital Project Sheet regarding the Main Street Widening Project are attached hereto as Exhibit B.
- **Section 5.** Carryover. Pursuant to Sec. 106.345, *Ordinance Code*, funds shall carryover from fiscal year to fiscal year. Any funds remaining after all obligations have been made regarding the Main Street Widening Project shall be returned to the JIA/CRA "Unallocated Plan Authorized Expenditures" activity within the Plan Authorized Expenditures Category for the fiscal year in which the funds become excess.
- **Section 6. Oversight.** The Agency Board requests that the Mayor direct the Public Works Department to provide oversight on the Main Street Widening Project utilizing the City's Procurement process.
- Section 7. Contract Execution Authorized. Pursuant to Sec. 500.116, *Ordinance Code*, the Mayor, or his or her designee, and the Corporation Secretary, are authorized to execute and deliver all contracts and documents related to the Main Street Widening Project.
- **Section 8. Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon a majority vote of the JIA/CRA and upon execution by the Chair.

## US-17 (Main Street) Project Synopsis

US-17 is currently a two-lane rural roadway with considerable development thru Oceanway and notable traffic growth in the area due to the success of the River City Marketplace area. Traffic volumes along the corridor have increased from about 12,000 vehicles/day in 2010 to 18,000 vehicles in 2020.

The City of Jacksonville and Nassau County have requested that this corridor be widened from two to four lanes due to the current conditions and anticipated future growth. The North Florida Transportation Planning Organization has placed this corridor as a high priority to be widened from two-to four lanes from I-295 to SR-200. The logical plan is to begin widening from I-295 and work north as funding is available.

Thru Oceanway the recommended typical section is a five-lane urban section with a multi-use trail along the east side of the roadway (CSX railroad owns all frontage on the west side of the roadway). This roadway typical section will fit within the existing right-of-way; however, additional right-of-way will be need for storm water retention ponds.

FDOT has identified two possible funding scenarios for the first projects on this portion of the corridor. Scenario1 will widen from I-295 to Airport Center Drive and Scenario 2 will widen from I-295 to Max Leggett Parkway (both scenarios are attached with an anticipated schedule). The funding scenarios are a blend of COJ, FDOT and NFTPO funding to deliver the project.
