ONE CITY. ONE JACKSONVILLE.

WHEREAS: Mobility Week is a cooperative effort by the Florida Department of Transportation and its 278 partner agencies to promote awareness of safe, multimodal transportation choices by hosting an annual collection of outreach events; and

WHEREAS: Mobility Week is an ideal time for counties, cities, and transportation agencies to highlight achievements, introduce new initiatives, and implement new policies promoting sustainable transportation; and

WHEREAS: Mobility Week is an opportunity for individuals to explore various transportation choices available and consider how sustainable travel choices reduce traffic congestion, benefit the environment, and improve community health; and
