Susan L. Fraser is a graduate of the University of Florida, School of Landscape Architecture. As a Registered Landscape Architect between 1984 and 2011, Susan served as the Landscape Architecture Plans Reviewer and Inspector for Clay County between 1989 and 1999 in addition to her role as a leader in the Planning Department.

Susan began her career as a Landscape Architect for the Haskell Company, preparing site plans and landscape plans for private sector clients. She joined Clay County in 1989, serving as Senior Planner, Chief Planner and, for the last five years of her tenure, as its Planning Director. Responsible for long range planning and site plan reviews, as Planning Director Susan led the development of the Branan Field Master Plan and its land development regulations, establishing open space, park, transportation and development standards for this 20,000 acre area adjacent to the First Coast Expressway in northwest Clay County. Susan also served as the project manager for permitting and construction of the US 17 Bike Trail on Fleming Island.

Susan returned to private practice in 2003, opening her consulting firm, SLF Consulting, to offer entitlement services to land owners and developers in Clay County in the areas of land use, zoning and transportation planning. She has served as Consultant Planner to the Town of Orange Park, City of Keystone Heights and most recently, as the Interim Community Development Director for Baker County.
