
Vision and Values

Delivering the rail advantage


- Critical advantage of efficiency: a CSX locomotive can haul a ton of freight 483 miles on one gallon of fuel.
 - Reduces the carbon footprint of transportation
 - Improves air quality by emitting less nitrogen oxide
 - Reduces highway traffic, easing congestion
 - Fosters economic growth with reduced environmental impact




