Q2 2026	As-Needed Professional Design Services for Public Works Projects	Professional Engineering design, permitting, and all other professional services needed for bidding and construction of Public Works projects. Services will be provided on an as-needed or “on-call” basis and may include engineering, architecture, surveying and mapping, right of way acquisition, program management, landscape architecture, land planning, and utility design.	20% Participation
Q2 2026	CEI Services for First Responder Hurricane Safe Room	Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection services required for contract administration, inspection, and testing for the construction of the First Responder Hurricane Safe Room. The project includes an approximately 25,000 square foot emergency structure built to FEMA P-361 criteria, along with utilities, site work, and a stormwater pond.	20% Participation
Q2 2026	CEI Services for Angel Lakes Drainage Improvements	Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection services which are required for constructability reviews, contract administration, inspection, and materials sampling and testing for the construction of the Angel Lakes Drainage Improvements project. The project extends approximately 2 miles along V.C. Johnson Road and Angel Lake Drive West from Dunn Avenue to the end of Angel Lake Drive West and includes ditch filling, culvert replacement, swales with inlets, and new sidewalks.	20% Participation
Q3 2026	Professional Design Services for Art Museum Drive Sidewalks	Professional Engineering design, permitting, and all other professional services needed for bidding and construction of Art Museum Drive Sidewalks. The limits are from Beach Boulevard to Atlantic Boulevard. Project will include bridge construction and modifications to the slope walls under the Emerson Street Overpass.	20% Participation

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Q3 2026	Professional Design Services for Brown Eastside Branch Replacement (Library)	Professional Engineering design, permitting, and all other professional services needed for bidding and construction of Brown Eastside Branch library replacement. The new facility will be approximately 20,000 sf and located in the same area. The new library will focus on serving children and teens as well as adult learners.	20% Participation
Q4 2026	Design-Build Services for Small Active and Passive Parks Design-Build Projects	Furnishing design-build services for small active and passive park improvement projects, including planning, design, permitting, and construction of park facilities and related infrastructure at multiple locations throughout the City of Jacksonville.	20% Participation
Q4 2026	CEI Services for Starratt Road and Yellow Bluff Road Intersection Improvement	Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection services required for constructability reviews, contract administration, inspection, and testing for the construction of Starratt Road and Yellow Bluff Road Intersection Improvement. The project consists of roadway improvements including milling and resurfacing, signing, lighting, signalization, and drainage.	20% Participation
Q1 2027	CEI Services for Sports Fields at New Fairgrounds	Professional Construction Engineering and Inspection services which are required for constructability reviews, contract administration, inspection, and materials sampling and testing for the construction of sports fields at the New Fairgrounds. The project will support athletic facilities development at the new site location.	20% Participation
