RE: Renewal of the Charge of the Landmarking Committee

The Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission is charged with conducting an ongoing survey and inventory of historic buildings, areas, and archaeological sites in the City of Jacksonville, to plan for their preservation, and to identify potential landmarks and potential landmark sites.

To that end, and pursuant to Section 76.106(b), *Ordinance Code*, in August 2025 I created the Landmarking Committee to fulfill this mission. The Landmarking Committee was charged with identifying potential landmarks and landmark sites, providing information and resources to the owners of identified potential landmarks and landmark sites, and promoting landmark designation to interested owners.

I hereby renew the charge of the Landmarking Committee, as stated in the original Charge Memorandum, effective June 1, 2026. I would like to thank Commissioner Julia Epstein for continuing to serve as Chairperson.
