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IV. Executive Director's Report

Timothy Johnson informed the Advisory Committee of the upcoming 55th Annual Police Officers' and Firefighters' Pension Trustees' Conference, which will be held in Daytona Beach Shores in September. He noted that he would send additional information to the Committee, particularly to new member Austin Halker. Mr. Johnson described the conference as an excellent training opportunity for members of Chapter 175 and 185 plans, such as the PFPF, as well as an opportunity to network with representatives of similar pension plans throughout Florida.

Mr. Johnson also reminded Committee members that the Fund's annual surveys are distributed around this time each year. A member satisfaction survey is sent to retirees, while a separate survey is provided to Trustees and Advisory Committee members regarding engagement and goals for the upcoming year. He encouraged Committee members to participate and provide their feedback. Mr. Johnson also reminded the Committee of the upcoming Summer Social, which will be held this Saturday at the newly renovated FOP building.

Chuck Hayes updated the Advisory Committee on the progress of the Fund's annual affidavits, which serve as proof of life for retirees and beneficiaries. He reported that 3,128 affidavits were mailed on July 6 and, as of the meeting date, only 1,028 remained outstanding. Mr. Hayes noted that this represented good progress at this stage of the process.

Mr. Hayes also reported that the upcoming October quarterly DROP enrollment is expected to be record-breaking, with 91 appointments already scheduled.

James Holderfield informed Committee members that the FOP building's grand opening celebration would be held the following day and that members of the Committee, along with PFPF staff, were invited to attend. He remarked that the newly renovated building is beautiful.

Steve Lundy discussed the history of the DROP and historical enrollment trends. He noted that two of the primary factors influencing the size of DROP enrollment classes are hiring trends approximately 20 years earlier and recent collective bargaining increases, both of which can significantly affect when members become eligible and choose to enter the DROP.
