II. Public Speaking

John Keane addressed the Advisory Committee and referenced copies of the PFPF \$3 Billion Celebration booklet that he had provided to Committee members. He thanked James Holderfield for remembering the heroes of the September 11, 2001, attacks. Mr. Keane stated that it was shameful that the City of Jacksonville had not scheduled an official memorial event for the upcoming 25th anniversary of September 11. He concluded by thanking the Advisory Committee for its service to PFPF members.

III. Consent Agenda – Action Items: a-c; Items d-e to be received as information.

Thomas Lumpkin moved to approve the Consent Agenda, and Michael Pelletier seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.

Thomas Lumpkin asked about the large number of DROP applications and the members who had withdrawn their applications.

Steve Lundy responded that 82 DROP applications appeared on the agenda, while approximately 91–92 members had originally signed applications. The 9–10 members whose applications did not appear on the agenda had withdrawn them, presumably intending to enroll in the DROP at a later date. The remaining 82 members could withdraw their applications through the September Board of Trustees meeting if they decide not to enter the DROP in October 2026.

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IV. Executive Director's Report

a. Analysis of DROP Statistics

Steve Lundy presented the Analysis of DROP Statistics, noting that the quarter's 82 DROP enrollments constituted the largest quarterly DROP class since the program's inaugural year in 1999.

b. Annual Affidavit Update

Chuck Hayes updated the Advisory Committee on the annual affidavit collection process. He reported that approximately 500 affidavits remained outstanding, which was a typical number at this stage of the process. Mr. Hayes noted that many members wait until the deadline approaches to return their affidavits and said he did not anticipate any difficulty collecting the remaining affidavits this year.

James Holderfield asked Chuck Hayes to notify Advisory Committee members of any outstanding affidavits as the deadline approaches so that they could assist in contacting nonresponders.

Timothy Johnson informed the Advisory Committee that the annual Trustee Breakfast would be held during the hour preceding the October Board of Trustees meeting. He invited Advisory Committee members to attend and described the breakfast as a good opportunity to meet invited public officials and highlight the PFPF's work.

James Holderfield reminded Advisory Committee members to complete the annual engagement survey.

Timothy Johnson explained that the survey responses help establish the PFPF's goals and objectives for the coming year. Staff will review the responses during the annual retreat on September 17.
