P-27-17 (Blue Cypress Pool)

Introduction: Part 1

During the design of civil infrastructure for the new Blue Cypress Pool, it became evident that a new water line connection for fire protection would be required for the proposed facility. Furthermore, the existing gravity sewer line proposed to serve the new pool is in disrepair and in need of replacement. Accordingly, the scope of work under this amendment will provide for survey, design, permitting, and certification for a new water line, and an "in-kind" gravity sewer line replacement for Blue Cypress Pool. The original scope of services excluded water and sewer design and permitting under the assumption that existing connection points would be sufficient.

Survey Services

Subconsultant will perform additional 3D topographic survey of approximately 2 acres at the Blue Cypress Park site in Jacksonville, FL. The additional survey will include additional area located east of the existing survey on a 25' grid as shown on the attached aerial. The survey will include 3D topography of the area with any buildings, driveways, sidewalks, above ground utility indicators to underground utilities, trees, landscape, signs, light poles, drainage, fences, parking, curbing and other topography features on site. The survey information will be adequate to design the required water and sewer improvements for the proposed Blue Cypress Pool.

Engineering Design Services

Utilizing an updated topographic survey, GAI will prepare Engineering Plans and Details sufficient for permit and construction. This task is further outlined below.

- GAI shall design the Potable service from JEA's water distribution main along University Boulevard to within 5' of the proposed building.
- This task includes GAI's attendance of up to two (2) design coordination meetings with the design team.
- GAI will coordinate the design of the potable water service as required by the Governmental Agencies (JEA and Florida Department of Environmental Protection) with the design team.
- Obtain service letters from the utility providers based on demands determined by the appropriate design team member.
- GAI shall provide the required engineering design/calculations, CAD generated construction drawings and specifications related to the potable water service.

Permitting, Construction Administration, and Permit Certification Services

GAI will prepare and submit application to JEA and Florida Department of Environmental Protection required for construction of Civil-Site improvements. GAI will attend one (1) meeting with the permitting agencies to help facilitate permit approvals. GAI will also provide for construction administration services and prepare/process the required permit certifications upon completion of construction for the proposed water and sewer improvements as part of the overall project construction timeline.

Introduction: Part 2

During Part #1 design of the water services, fire services, and gravity sanitary sewer main for the new Blue Cypress Pool, the City and JEA discovered that the current sewer discharge location is unknown. The City has requested a proposal for design and permitting of a new private sanitary sewer pump station to serve the existing community center and the new Blue Cypress Pool. This design will include a new

force main to University Boulevard where it will connect to an existing JEA force main within the right-ofway. Accordingly, the scope of work under this amendment will provide for engineering design, permitting, and certification for the new pump station and associated force main.

Engineering Design Services

GAI will prepare Engineering Plans and Details sufficient for permit and construction. This task is further outlined below.

- GAI shall locate and design the private sanitary sewer pump station and associated force main to University Boulevard.
- This task includes GAI's attendance of up to two (2) design coordination meetings with the design team.
- GAI will coordinate the design of the private sanitary sewer pump station as required by the Governmental Agencies (JEA and Florida Department of Environmental Protection) with the design team.
- Obtain force main connection letter from the utility provider based on flows determined by the appropriate design team member.
- GAI shall provide the required engineering design/calculations, CAD generated construction drawings and specifications related to the sanitary sewer pump station.

Permitting, Construction Administration, and Permit Certification Services

GAI will prepare and submit application to JEA and Florida Department of Environmental Protection required for construction of Civil-Site improvements. GAI will attend one (1) meeting with the permitting agencies to help facilitate permit approvals. The scope of work includes responding up to two (2) rounds of review comments for each permitting agency. If the review comments require extensive effort that is unusual for the magnitude and/or scope of this project, it will be considered an unforeseen circumstance and therefore, not included in this scope of work.

GAI will also provide for construction administration services and prepare/process the required permit certifications upon completion of construction for the proposed sanitary sewer improvements as part of the overall project construction timeline.
