ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR AN DISCLAIMING AN OPENED AND IMPROVED PORTION OF INTERSTATE CENTER COURT RIGHT-OF-WAY AS RECORDED IN OFFICIAL RECORDS BOOK 5575, PAGE 2124, OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, LOCATED IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 8, AT THE REQUEST OF RICKJAYMAR PROPERTIES LLC: PROVIDING APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. An opened and improved portion of Interstate Center Court Right-of-Way as recorded in Official Records Book 5575, Page 2124, of the current public records of Duval County, Florida, located in Council District 8, a depiction and description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit 1 and incorporated herein by this reference, is hereby closed and abandoned and/or disclaimed at the request of Rickjaymar Properties LLC (the "Applicant").

The Applicant has paid the closure application with encroachment fee of \$2,607.00 and this sum has been deposited into the City's General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there were no objections to the Applicant's request.

Section 2. Purpose. The Applicant owns the fee parcel adjacent to the closure area (See R.E. No. 020690-0110 for location

purposes) and has requested the closure in order to make the fenced entrance to its commercial property private, with little to no physical changes to the appearance of the property.

abandonment by the City of its interests in the right-of-way is subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.





Location Map




