subject to Applicant's execution and delivery to the City of a Hold Harmless Covenant, in substantially the same form attached hereto as Exhibit 2 and incorporated herein by this reference. Accordingly, the 3 closure and abandonment of the right-of-way shall not be recorded in the public records until execution and delivery to the City by the Applicant of the required Hold Harmless Covenant.

IN CONSIDERATION for the closure and/or abandonment of City right-of-way or easement areas pursuant to CITY ORDINANCE 2025-_____, a copy of which is attached hereto and incorporated by reference (the "Ordinance"), located near RE# 019531-0170 in Council District 8 and established in the Official Public Records of Duval County, Florida, Ordinance 72-238-96.

Grantor, its successors and assigns, holds harmless, indemnifies, and will defend CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, its members, officials, officers, employees, and agents against any claim, action, loss, damage, injury, liability, cost and expense of whatever kind or nature (including, but not by way of limitation, attorney fees and court costs) arising out of injury (whether mental or corporeal) to persons, including death, or damage to property, arising out of or incidental to the use of the abandoned right-of-way or easement areas, more particularly described in Exhibit "A," attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference (the "Property"); including, but not limited to such injuries or damages resulting from flooding or erosion.
