### Economics

- Highest sub-population of unemployed - 23%
- 30.6% employed earning less than \$14,999
- Unemployed on SSI receive maximum benefit of \$794



### Barriers

- Lack of knowledge of programs and supports
- Programs and services operate in silos
- Priced out of housing
- Accessible services
- Confusing eligibilities
- Digital Divide
- Consent
