

Deena Wallace, a Title IX consultant, owns and operates an outside investigations business, where she has served as a consultant, advisor, decision maker and outside investigator to private K-12 schools, individuals, colleges and universities (pursuant to Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972) and companies (pursuant to Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964).
