## HOW CAN WE HELP YOU? REPORT ROADWAY ISSUES USING MYJAX OR REQUEST BIKE RACKS FOR BUSSINESSES USING JAXRAX

### SIDEWALKS AND BICYCLE FACILITIES


Does your neighborhood have missing sidewalks, damaged signs, or other issues that the City should be made aware of? Perhaps there is debris in your favorite bike lane that you use to get to work each morning, or you've encountered a walk signal button that isn't working properly. It's possible you've noted sidewalk issues on your walk to school that affect the quality of life for you and your fellow classmates. Remember, the City of Jacksonville works for you, the residents, and when everyday community members flag these issues, they can be addressed more efficiently. All Jaxons, of all ages and abilities, may report roadway issues in their neighborhoods by using MyJax, a convenient online reporting tool (and phone app) that sends your comments directly to City staff. Simply visit [myjax.custhelp.com/app/home](http://myjax.custhelp.com/app/home) and submit your comments using the online form. Addressing specific issues only takes a few minutes but can make a world of difference in turnaround time.



### OFF STREET BICYCLE PARKING

Are you a private business with employees and patrons that ride their bikes to your establishment each day? Eligible businesses may request the City install standard, inverted-U bike racks through our JaxRax program, providing employees and visitors a safe place to lock their bikes. Just visit the City's Bike-Ped page at [coj.net/pedbike](http://coj.net/pedbike) to submit the online JaxRax request form. Our staff will then visit the site to determine if it is a feasible location for the racks, and next contact you to coordinate installation. **COJ LAUNCHES BIKE NETWORK TOOL**

The On-Street Bikeways and Shared-Use Paths (Trails) Network map tool went live in July, allowing the public to identify the most direct and comfortable facilities to travel by bicycle (or by foot along shared-use paths) to reach schools, employment centers, retail areas, and other essential destinations throughout Jacksonville. The map tool is the first comprehensive inventory of existing, planned, and funded bicycle infrastructure, providing information to help state, local, and private sector engineers and developers integrate critical network connections into their roadway designs. Users can use the map tool to create printable maps, explore bike routes to destinations, download the network's attribute table (data), and more. 
