IV. Executive Director's Report

Timothy Johnson provided the Advisory Committee with an overview of the upcoming year's business cycle. The PFPF Staff evaluation was completed in November, and merit increases are scheduled to begin in January. The core work cycle for the new year remains consistent with previous years. Early in the year, the actuarial valuation will be presented to the Advisory Committee for informational purposes, followed by the chapter funds application process in March. This will be succeeded by the annual audit, culminating in the Annual Members' Meeting in April.

Timothy Johnson said that a significant item on the agenda is the search for the next Executive Director – Plan Administrator. The Board will initiate this process by crafting and posting a new job description, anticipating high interest from candidates. The first round of interviews is planned for June, and a decision is likely to be made by August.

Timothy Johnson added that his contract concludes in November, marking his retirement after 10 years of service as Executive Director – Plan Administrator.

James Holderfield stated he looks forward to a fruitful year and expressed that Mr. Johnson will be missed when he retires.
