#### Manager Update Workshop

#### a. Principal Asset Management

Gregory Pittenger and Darren Kleis of Principal Asset Management gave a presentation on the Principal U.S. Property Account (the Fund), outlining its structure, strategy, and performance for the Jacksonville Police & Fire Pension Fund. They highlighted Principal Real Estate's scale as a top-10 global real estate manager, the Account's 43-year track record, and its core, daily-valued open-end structure. The presenters detailed the Fund's diversified portfolio—spanning industrial, residential, office, retail, and alternative sectors—with strategic overweights to high-conviction areas such as industrial and residential, and an underweight position in traditional office. They emphasized the Fund's strong long-term results, including consistent net operating income (NOI) growth, income return outperformance versus the NFI-ODCE benchmark, and a disciplined focus on structural growth drivers, demographic trends, and necessity-based real estate.

They also reviewed the Fund's sector allocation, geographic diversification, debt profile, and property-level activity, including acquisitions, dispositions, and ongoing development projects. The Account maintains a conservative leverage ratio, a balanced maturity schedule, and a robust tenant base across markets with favorable long-term fundamentals. For the Jacksonville Police & Fire Pension Fund specifically, the Account has grown from an initial \$30 million investment in 2013 to a value of over \$67 million as of October 31, 2025. Overall, the presentation underscored the Fund's disciplined investment process, stable platform, and ability to generate durable income and competitive risk-adjusted returns across market cycles.
