QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR THE 2025 ELECTION FOR THE FIRE TRUSTEE

- Due to the expiration of the term of our Fire Trustee, an election must be held. Please note the following important information:
- Chapter 22 creates the Pension Board of Trustees including one Firefighter who is a member or a qualified member of the Fund. The Board of Trustees is the sole entity responsible for the administration of the Jacksonville Police and Fire Pension Fund, and the investment and reinvestment of its assets.
- All active Fire Members on the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department payroll who are Members of the Police and Fire Pension Fund are eligible to become a candidate.
- Qualifying period for the 2025 Election for the Fire Trustee will open at 9 AM on Monday, July 21, 2025, and remain open until 4 PM on Friday, October 3, 2025.
- Candidates must qualify in person at the Police and Fire Pension Fund Office, One W. Adams Street, Suite 100 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM, Monday thru Friday.
- Candidates' full name should be given, the same name provided on your Pension Fund membership application (no nicknames), and you must bring your official identification card in order to qualify for the election. Candidates must also provide a short bio of 100 words or less.
- All details regarding the upcoming election will be published on our website at www.jaxpfpf.coj.net along with the names and bios of the candidates once the qualification period is closed. Candidates will be listed in alphabetical order.
- The Fire Trustee shall be elected by Firefighters who are Members of the Police and Fire Pension Fund. The top candidate receiving the most votes will take office in January, 2026 and will complete a 4 year term.
- Each Candidate may qualify for only one Police and Fire Pension Fund body per election cycle.
