### QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR THE 2025 ELECTION FOR POLICE ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBER

Due to the expiration of the term of one Police Advisory Committee Member, an election must be held. Please note the following important information:

- Section 121.103 creates the Pension Advisory Committee composed of three Police Officers who are qualified members of the Fund. All applications for pension benefits shall be referred to and reviewed by the Advisory Committee. The Trustees shall establish the rules and regulations for the election.
- All active Police Members on the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office payroll who are Members of the Police and Fire Pension Fund are eligible to become a candidate.
- Qualifying period for the 2021 Election for one Police Advisory Committee Member will open at 9AM on Monday, July 21, 2025, and remain open until 4PM on Friday, October 3, 2025.
- Candidates must qualify in person at the Police and Fire Pension Fund Office, One W. Adams Street, Suite 100 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM, Monday thru Friday.
- Candidates' full name should be given (no nicknames), and you must bring your official identification card in order to qualify for the election. Candidates must also provide a short bio of 100 words or less.
- All details regarding the upcoming election will be published on our website at [www.jaxpfpf.coj.net](http://www.jaxpfpf.coj.net) along with the names and bios of the candidates once the qualification period is closed. Candidates will be listed in alphabetical order.
- The Police Advisory Committee Member shall be elected by Police Officers who are Members of the Police and Fire Pension Fund. The top candidate receiving the most votes will take office in January, 2026 and will complete a 4 year term.
- Each Candidate may qualify for only one Police and Fire Pension Fund body per election cycle.
