QUALIFICATION PERIOD FOR THE 2025 ELECTION FOR RETIRED ADVISORY COMMITTEE MEMBER

Due to the expiration of the term of the Retired Advisory Committee Member, an election must be held. Please note the following important information:

- Section 121.103 creates the Pension Advisory Committee composed of members or qualified members of the Fund. All applications for pension benefits shall be referred to and reviewed by the Advisory Committee. The Trustees shall establish the rules and regulations for the election.
- All **Retired** Police and Fire Members of the Police and Fire Pension Fund are eligible to become a candidate and vote.
- Qualifying period for the 2025 Election of the Retired Advisory Committee Member will open at 9AM on September 15, 2025, and remain open until 4PM on Friday, October 3, 2025.
- Candidates must qualify in person at the Police and Fire Pension Fund Office, One W. Adams Street, Suite 100 between the hours of 9 AM and 4 PM, Monday thru Friday.
 - To qualify for the Retired Advisory election, you will need to bring your official identification card (such as a Driver's License), and you will need to provide a short written bio of 100 words or less.
- All details regarding the upcoming election will be mailed to you and published on our website at www.jaxpfpf.coj.net along with the names and bios of the candidates once the qualification period is closed. Candidates will be listed in alphabetical order.
- The Retired Advisory Committee Member shall be elected by Retired Police and Fire Members of the Police and Fire Pension Fund. The candidate receiving the most votes will take office in January, 2026 and will complete the term thru December 31, 2029.
