



# City of Jacksonville LDPM Updated Bike & Pedestrian Guidance

The City Mobility Plan supports various modes of travel, reducing vehicle miles traveled and improving the quality of life for residents. The LDPM now has stand alone design guidance for sidewalks and bicycle facilities.

**CITY'S GOAL:  
PEDESTRIAN SAFETY**

To eliminate traffic fatalities by 2035 using a Vision 0 approach




The basis of the new bike and pedestrian design guidance is safety and comfort for those using the facilities. From shared use paths and cycle tracks to traditional bike lanes and bike parking, the LDPM now includes definitions of each type of facility as well as information on **typical layouts** • **minimum dimensions** • **setbacks** • **links to relevant design criteria**.



## HOW SHOULD YOU DETERMINE WHICH FACILITY IS APPROPRIATE FOR YOUR PROJECT?



**Bicycle facilities are required on all new or reconstructed streets**, so the LDPM now includes helpful tables that outline the required bicycle facilities in order of preference. Based on street classification, design speed, and location based on FHWA Bikeway Selection Guide 2019 and FDOT Multimodal Quality Level of Service Handbook 2023.



Make sure to confirm your selection with the **City of Jacksonville Traffic Engineering or Bike-Ped Coordinator** prior to final design.
