Program Summary: TEAM UP is an after school program that provides academic instruction, tutoring and support, as well as, enrichment activities, such as field trips, dance, sports and arts to low income, at risk kids. These programs are housed in elementary and middle schools, and provide services directly after school for approximately 3 hours per day, five days per week.

Successes: Our Team-UP program is towards the end of the Youth Fit For Life program. This program has really encouraged the students to eat healthy and be active. Several students earned an opportunity to attend a Jacksonville Jaguars game on November 25th sponsored through Honor Rows. The students truly enjoyed themselves and look forward to participating in more activities through the program. The male cooking class has begun and students are learning ways to safely navigate through the kitchen, learning healthy behaviors when eating and make healthy recipes that requires no baking. The academic portion of the program has become a safety net for Rufus E. Payne. Students who will be tested on the 2012-13 FCAT have been placed in small groups in order to differentiate instruction. Students were given an assessment that will be used to drive instruction. Every 6 weeks students will be re-assessed to see their growth. Challenges: Our primary challenge is getting students picked up on time. We have started to enforce the late policy and parents understand the consequences of picking up their child(ren) late

- 90% of students attending Jacksonville Journey TEAM UP sites for 60 days or more will not receive a Class 3 or 4 referral/conduct violation and will be equal to or exceed the school baseline.
- 60% of students attending on a regular basis will attend TEAM UP for 60 days or more.
- Jacksonville Journey TEAM UP programs will maintain at least 90% of their projected average daily attendance.
