Program Summary: TEAM UP is an after school program that provides academic instruction, tutoring and support, as well as, enrichment activities, such as field trips, dance, sports and arts to low income, at risk kids. These programs are housed in elementary and middle schools, and provide services directly after school for approximately 3 hours per day, five days per week.

Successes: Our school will be participating in FCAT Boot camp during our Team Up school program. Our academic hour has been extended one extra hour to help our level 1 and 2 students from 3rd-5th grade. The focus will be on small group settings in order to maximize the learning instruction that will be given during the extended hour. Arts and Crafts self-portraits were a great success with our K-2 grade students, the students were very excited to see themselves in a mirror and then draw themselves on paper, after they finished the self-portraits each student described themselves as to who they would be in the future. Team-Up students from K-5th grade participated in the Spring Egg Hunt, candy and eggs were donated by parents and friends from the community for the event. The hunt took place at our Team Up site; over one thousand eggs were hidden around the school.

Challenges: Our primary challenge is attendance. Long term and short term incentives have been put in place to promote students attendance.

- 90% of students attending Jacksonville Journey TEAM UP sites for 60 days or more will be absent from school less than 21 days and will be equal to or exceed the school baseline.
- 90% of students attending Jacksonville Journey TEAM UP sites for 60 days or more will not receive a Class 3 or 4 referral/conduct violation and will be equal to or exceed the school baseline.
- 60% of students attending on a regular basis will attend TEAM UP for 60 days or more.
- Jacksonville Journey TEAM UP programs will maintain at least 90% of their projected average daily attendance.
