

WHEREAS, 'the Contract provided for three (3) one year extensions at the sole discretion of JHFA and all three extensions were exercised but no signed amendments to the Contract can be found and the parties wish to ratify the exercise of the three extension options just as If a First, Second and Third Amendment to the Contract had been signed by the parties; and

WHEREAS, the JHFA Board of Directors at its Regular Meeting on March 21<sup>st</sup>, 2018, authorized a three-month term extension of the Contract through September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2018, to synchronize with the City's fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to letter dated June 7, 2018 from the City of Jacksonville Procurement Division, Professional Services Evaluation Committee, to JHFA, approval was granted to extend the period of Contract services from July 1, 2018 through September 30, 2018 and increase the maximum indebtedness under the Contract by \$30,000 to a new not-to-exceed total maximum of \$510,000; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to enter into this Fourth Amendment to extend the term of Services of the Contract, and increase the maximum indebtedness, accordingly.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto agree as follows:

- The above stated recitals are accurate, true and correct and, by this reference are incorporated herein and are made a part hereof.
- 2. For the purpose of this Fourth Amendment, the parties hereby mutually agree to

effectuate and ratify the three (3) consecutive one-year term extensions, as previously authorized ("Renewed Term"), in accordance with Paragraph 4 of the Contract, as follows:

- First Amendment extending the term from July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016.
- Second Amendment extending the term from July 1, 2016 to June 30, 2017.
- Third Amendment extending the term from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018.
- 3. The parties hereto agree that the Renewed Term of the Contract shall be further extended for an additional three (3) months from July 1, 2018 to September 30, 2018 and Consultant shall receive a total of Thirty Thousand Dollars (\$30,000.00) for compensation for this three month period payable Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) per month on an invoice basis similar to the first 4 years of the Renewed Term.
- 4. Concurrently, the parties hereby mutually agree to effectuate and ratify the three (3) consecutive increases of maximum indebtedness under the Contract, as previously authorized ("Increased Maximum Indebtedness"), in accordance with Paragraph 3 of the Contract, as follows:
  - First Amendment increasing the not-to-exceed maximum indebtedness by \$120,000.00 for Services, to a new not-to-exceed total maximum indebtedness of \$240,000.00.
  - Second Amendment increasing the not-to-exceed maximum indebtedness by \$120,000.00 for Services, to a new not-to-exceed total maximum indebtedness of \$360,000.00.
  - Third Amendment increasing the not-to-exceed maximum indebtedness by \$120,000.00 for Services, to a new not-to-exceed total maximum indebtedness of \$480,000.00.
- The parties further agree that the current Increased Maximum Indebtedness under the terms of Paragraph 3 of the Contract shall be increased by an additional \$30,000.00, as authorized, from \$480,000.00 to a new not-to-exceed total maximum indebtedness of \$510,000.00.
- Except as expressly amended in this Fourth Amendment, the provisions, terms and conditions of the Contract shall remain unchanged and shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- 7. This Fourth Amendment may be executed in counterpart and electronic (.pdf format) signature, the counterpart and .pdf copies of which when taken together, shall be deemed to constitute an entire and original document.
