#### CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING AND INSPECTION (CEI) SERVICES:

#### I. GENERAL:

Services provided under this contract are for VIA Consulting Services, Inc. (Consultant) to provide Construction Engineering and Inspection (CEI) services along with any required construction testing and other related professional services necessary to oversee the construction (by others) of 5 Riverfront Improvement Projects and 3 Park Improvement Projects.
