WHEREAS: Every business, industry, school and citizen can make a difference when it comes to conserving water both indoors and outdoors, thus promoting a healthy economy and communities; and


WHEREAS: Water conservation will continue to play an important role in the future protection and preservation of ground and surface water resources throughout our community.
