WHEREAS: Dr. William P. Bosworth, DO has been an active resident of Jacksonville in

the military, medical, and public spheres for over 80 years. A native of

Jacksonville, Dr. Bosworth graduated from Andrew Jackson High School; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bosworth served for over 50 years in both the United States Navy and

United States Marine Corp. During his time in the military, Dr. Bosworth earned his medical degree and joined the Navy Medical Corp. He provided

medical and primary care to hundreds of patients at his various duty stations.

WHEREAS: Dr. Bosworth returned to Jacksonville, retiring as Captain of the Medical

Corps in 1999. He continued to serve part-time at Naval Air Station

Jacksonville and other nearby stations until 2016; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bosworth has been an active member of the Mandarin and greater

Jacksonville communities for over 50 years. He established his family practice in Mandarin in 1974. He is a founding member of the Mandarin and San Jose Rotary Clubs, a charter member of the Mandarin Museum & Historical Society, a member of 12 Medical Organizations, served as the President of the Mandarin Community Club, and was elected to both the Duval County

School Board and Jacksonville Sports and Entertainment Commission; and

WHEREAS: While an elected official, Dr. Bosworth helped build ten new schools

throughout Jacksonville, pushed for Tobacco Free Schools, and helped expand extended day care to all elementary schools. He has been the recipient of 15 community service recognitions and awards since 1982,

demonstrating his commitment to his craft and his community; and

WHEREAS: Dr. Bosworth has helped thousands of neighbors and fellow service members

during his tenure as a physician and community leader. To this day, he remains a committed public servant, doctor, veteran, and community

member here in Jacksonville.
