WHEREAS: Alan Worley is the Founder and CEO of Money Pages and the President of 3D Digital. He has spent nearly three decades in the marketing sphere and has an extensive background in print and digital media; and

WHEREAS: Alan launched Money Pages in Jacksonville, Florida, in 2001 with a desire to provide affordable marketing to local businesses. It has grown to serve over 12 million households with operations in six states and was awarded the 2021, 2017, 2016, 2013, and 2012 Best Places to Work on the First Coast by the Jacksonville Business Journal; and

WHEREAS: Alan was recognized as Jacksonville Business Journal's 40 under 40 in 2013 and has served on the Mayor's Advisory Commission on Television, Motion Picture & Commercial Production since 2014, and as Chair since 2018; and

WHEREAS: Under Alan's leadership, the Film & Television Office along with the Mayor's Advisory Commission on Television, Motion Picture & Commercial Production successfully hosted the Annual Jacksonville Film & Television Industry Awards Receptions, and the inaugural Television, Digital Media & Music Industry Forum; and

WHEREAS: Since 2018, the 240 permitted productions have led to an economic impact of \$14 million and 2817 jobs created; and

WHEREAS: Alan continues to support Jacksonville as a steward of the community. He served on the UNF Coggin College of Business's Marketing Department Advisory Council, the Better Business Bureau Board of Directors, the TaxSlayer Gator Bowl Marketing Committee, and the Gator Bowl Charities Advisory Board, and supports many local nonprofits through the Money Pages Foundation.


