- WHEREAS:** Colonel Stanley "Stan" Jordan was born in Jacksonville, Florida on September 24, 1937. He graduated from Andrew Jackson High School and Jacksonville University before enlisting in the United States Army; and
- WHEREAS:** Col. Jordan dedicated four decades to military service to the United States. During his 40-year-stint in the U.S. Army, Col. Jordan earned degrees and status as an experience aviation and military leader; and
- WHEREAS:** Col. Jordan served his state and country as both a military and civilian leader. Following his time in the U.S. Army, Col. Jordan served eight years in the Florida House of Representatives. During this time, he advocated tirelessly for Veterans throughout the state. He chaired the committee on Military and Veteran Affairs, as well as served on various other committees; and
- WHEREAS:** When Jacksonville hosted the 2005 NFL Superbowl, Rep. Jordan convinced the Commissioner of the NFL to salute the greatest generation during a powerful pregame presentation; and
- WHEREAS:** Col. Jordan has all served as an appointed member of the Governor's Task Force. He chaired the Governor's Task Force on Education, through which he advocated for modernizing and improving Florida's public education system; and
- WHEREAS:** While active in State politics, Col. Jordan never forgot his hometown. He fiercely advocated for improvements to the Duval County Public School system, and served 17 years as a member, Vice Chairman, and Chairman of the Duval County School Board; and
- WHEREAS:** Col. Jordan has received countless awards for leadership and service to Jacksonville, the State of Florida, and the United States Military. Jacksonville is incredibly proud of and grateful for Col. Jordan's decades of leadership and advocacy for Veterans, Youth, and others in need in our community. We honor and salute Col. Jordan's legacy as a son of Jacksonville, Florida.


