ONE CITY. ONE JACKSONVILLE.

WHEREAS: The Auxiliary of the Jacksonville Children’s Hospital was formed 50 years ago on June 13, 1973 and later renamed the Wolfson Children’s Hospital Auxiliary; and

WHEREAS: The purpose of the Wolfson Children’s Hospital Auxiliary is to assist with the advancement of, the welfare of and render services to Wolfson Children’s Hospital and its patients through volunteer services; and

WHEREAS: Wolfson Children’s Hospital Auxiliary volunteers provide support in 17 service functions to bring aid and comfort to patients and their family members and to assist staff; and

WHEREAS: Over the last half century, Wolfson Children’s Auxiliary volunteers have generously devoted more than 1.1 million hours serving our community’s smallest patients and their families; and

WHEREAS: Over the past decade alone, Auxiliary members devoted nearly 200,000 hours representing a value of more than \$4.5 million; and

WHEREAS: The Wolfson Children’s Hospital Auxiliary through its fundraising efforts has donated more than \$1 million for hospital equipment and patient care.


