

- 1. Jacksonville Litter League begins on July 3 and will end on August 30.
- 2. Each team, led by a crucially important captain, must have a team name and a roster of no more than 20 players. Any player under 13 must be accompanied by a parent, guardian, or another responsible individual at least 18.
- 3. Team captains must register with Keep Jacksonville Beautiful at JaxNHOrg.coj.net. Select "Non-Organization" when registering. Email your team's name and roster to ddurbec@coj.net.
- 4. Each player or parent/guardian of a minor player must sign in on a Participant Sign in Sheet/ Release of Liability form provided at each cleanup.
- 5. Teams will submit their cleanup stats by Monday following a cleanup at JaxNHOrg.coj.net. To receive points, a photo of bags collected, a before/after photo of the area cleaned, along with a photo or scan of the completed Participant Sign in Sheet/ Release of Liability form, must be submitted via JaxNHOrg.coj.net or email, ddurbec@coj.net.
- 6. Keep Jacksonville Beautiful will provide each team with trash bags and gloves.
- 7. Team captains will be responsible for picking up supplies at the KJB office and distributing them to their teams. All unused supplies must be returned at the end of the League.
- 8. Teams will score 1 point for every full bag of litter collected. This scoring system is designed to motivate teams to collect more litter and understand the impact of their efforts on Jacksonville's cleanliness.
- 9. When cleaning up, no bulk, illegal dump sites, or homeless encampments will count toward the points awarded. All teams are cautioned against handling these materials. If a team encounters such an area they should call 630-City.
