

EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE PROCLAMATION 2020-005

June 2, 2020

TO: All Elected Officials, Department Heads, Division Chiefs, Boards and Independent Agencies – Consolidated City of Jacksonville

FROM: Lenny Curry, Mayor

SUBJECT: Proclamation to Terminate Declaration of Emergency in Accordance with Chapter 674, Part 3, *Jacksonville Ordinance Code* due to Elimination of Actual and Imminent Civil Unrest

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor by the Charter and as Chief Executive and Administrative Officer of the Consolidated Government, I hereby proclaim and declare that the state of civil emergency associated with recent violent protests declared pursuant to Emergency Executive Proclamation 2020-004 and Chapter 674, Part 3, *Ordinance Code* is hereby terminated.


WHEREAS, on May 31, 2020, due to immediate and ongoing civil unrest in the City, as Mayor of the City of Jacksonville, I determined that there had been an act of violence and a flagrant and substantial defiance of and resistance to a lawful exercise of public authority and that, on account thereof, there was reason to believe that there existed a clear and present danger of a riot or other general public disorder, widespread disobedience of the law and substantial injury to persons or property; all of which constituted an imminent threat to public peace or order and to the general welfare of the City; and

WHEREAS, I now determine that there no longer exists a state of civil emergency, and the threat of a repeat of the civil unrest and violent actions occurring and associated with the public demonstrations and protests currently remains low.

NOW THEREFORE, it is declared and ordered that the state of civil emergency declared pursuant to Chapter 674, *Ordinance Code* and Emergency Executive Proclamation 2020-004 (and any existing executive order issued thereunder) is hereby **TERMINATED**.


