## **Important Stadium and Game Day Information**

- **Game Day Security Information**

Please note that there will be wandings performed at all stadium gate entrances by gender-specific security personnel. Fans attending the game are strongly encouraged to make plans to arrive early for entry into the stadium to allow adequate time for these searches.

The following information details prohibited items for EverBank Field on November 1 for the Georgia vs. Florida game, in accordance with security procedures for all City of Jacksonville venues.

- **Prohibited Items**

- No purses or bags larger than 12 x 6 x 12 inches
- No cameras with lenses longer than six inches
- No coolers or containers including cans, cups and bottles
- No strollers or umbrellas
- No pets (except special services)
- No food or beverage from outside the stadium
- No seat cushions
- No video or audio recorders
- No whistles, noise makers, air horns or laser pointers
- No poles or sticks
- No knives, guns or any type of weapons or explosives
- No smoking (except in designated areas)
- No promotional materials
- Any other item deemed unacceptable by stadium management.
- **No Re-Entry**

There are no provisions to check items at the gates or in the stadium. Fans will be asked to take prohibited items to their vehicles or dispose of prohibited items at the entrance of the stadium. EverBank Field is NOT responsible for items left behind, lost, stolen or damaged. Possession of prohibited items is grounds for ejection from the stadium. Game tickets will be forfeited.

The Touchdown Clubs and all other gates will open at 1:30 p.m. for Saturday's 3:30 p.m. kickoff. Fans are encouraged to move into their seats sooner than usual to avoid last-minute gate pressure, which frequently occurs prior to kickoff.

Those with special needs should contact Stadium Operations at (904) 633-6100. They will need to provide the number of the gate they plan to enter as well as their special needs. Special service animals are welcome.

**Directions for accessing North End Zone (NEZ) Bleachers/Sections  
317(West) and 329 (East) Via Main Concourse:**

Guests entering through any ticket gate (stadium gates open at 1:30 pm, two hours prior to kickoff) can access the Main Concourse using the escalators inside Gates 2 or 3. You must exit the escalator on the Main Concourse to access the following routes below:

1. Access the Main Concourse and proceed to the stairs in the North End Zone (NEZ) on the Main Concourse behind Sections 222 and 224. Proceed up the stairwell to the 5th Level (next accessible level) and once you have exited the stairs, walk left or right down the pathway to the sections which will be labeled and staffed at the entrances to the seating sections.
2. If travelling on Ramps 2 or 3 (defined by the gates they are next to), proceed to the 5th level and use the stairs located at the ramp switchback. Staff will be there to direct you up the stairs. Once on the North End Zone (NEZ) Deck, walk left or right down the pathway to the sections which will be labeled and staffed at the entrances to the seating sections.
3. For ADA Access –
  - a. You may enter the stadium using the North Side Disabled Lobby entrance to access elevators. Take the elevator up to the 5th level and after departing the elevator, proceed left or right down the pathway to the sections which will be labeled and staffed at the entrances to the seating sections. The West Section of ADA Seating is accessible from the entrance to Section 320 and the East Section of ADA Seating is accessible from the entrance to Section 326.
  - b. OR You may enter the stadium through Gates 2 or 3 and access the escalators exiting on the Main Concourse. From the Main Concourse, proceed to the elevators in the North End of the Stadium (across from Sections 222 and 224 between the stairwells). Take the elevator up to the 5th level and after departing the elevator, proceed left or right down the pathway to the sections which will be labeled and staffed at the entrances to the seating sections. The West Section of ADA Seating is accessible from the entrance to Section 320 and the East Section of ADA Seating is accessible from the entrance to Section 326.

## **Parking, Traffic and Transportation**

There is limited parking around the stadium, and all reserved parking is full. **All automobiles without a reserved parking pass should not attempt to enter or travel in the Sports Complex area.** We encourage patrons to take one of the convenient JTA Shuttles or water taxis.

### ○ **Game Day Parking**

- Parking is extremely limited in the Sports Complex area. Available lots open at 6 a.m. For a complete listing of parking options, including City and private lots, visit [Flga.org](http://Flga.org).
- Unauthorized retail, commercial, marketing and promotional activities are strictly prohibited inside parking lots and tailgating areas without prior written approval (and proof of certification in the manner of a permit, etc.) from the City of Jacksonville. All violators will be escorted off the premises by the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office. These regulations are applicable in parking lots owned and/or leased by the City of Jacksonville and managed by SMG.

### ● **Game Day Stadium Shuttle Service** *by JTA*

Park and ride is strongly encouraged for the game. Several suburban locations are available, along with access from Downtown lots and Southbank hotels. Service begins Saturday, Nov. 1 at 11:30 a.m. through one hour post-game.

#### ● **Suburban Park-n-Ride locations**

- **Southside (J. Turner Butler & Philips Hwy.)**
  - Patrons coming from the Southside park free and ride the shuttle from J. Turner Butler Blvd. and Philips Highway just off I-95.
  - Roundtrip: \$12

- **Beaches - Wingate Park (501 Penman Rd. S.)**
  - Patrons park free and ride the shuttle from the beaches to the stadium.
  - Roundtrip: \$12
- **Downtown Park-n-Ride lot locations:**
  - **Skyway Convention Center**
    - Located at the Skyway Convention Center stop on Bay Street (across from the Prime Osborn Convention Center), patrons park free, paying only to ride directly to the stadium.
    - Roundtrip: \$7
  - **Kings Avenue Parking Garage**
    - In the San Marco area, the Kings Avenue Parking Garage offers convenient parking facilities. Park free and ride directly to the stadium.
    - Roundtrip: \$7
    - Pick up will be on the backside of the garage on the Montana Street side
  - **Bay Street (between Laura St. and Hogan St.)**
    - Adjacent to The Jacksonville Landing
    - No parking provided.
    - Roundtrip: \$7
- **Shuttle drop off locations**
  - Kings Avenue, Beaches, and JTB Park-n-Ride lot locations will use Lot 'B' located east of the stadium across Haines Street between Gates 3 and 4.
  - Skyway Convention Center and The Jacksonville Landing Park-n-Ride lot locations will use the ramp area that is located at the north end of the stadium. This pick-up and drop off area is located on the stadium property between Gates 2 and 3.
- **How to purchase Shuttle Passes**
  - Passes can be purchased during operational hours beginning at 11:30 p.m. at lot locations. Accepting cash AND debit/credit cards.
