SEPARATING **YOUR DEBRIS**

DEBRIS SEPARATION: Separate debris into the four categories shown below.

WHERE TO PLACE DEBRIS: Debris should be placed curbside, without blocking the roadway or storm drains. If you don't have a sidewalk, ditch or utility line in front of your house, place debris at the edge of your property before the curb.

PLEASE NOTE: Tree contractors are required by law to have award your property will not be picked up. DO NOT STACK AGAINST OR LEAN: Placing debris near or on mailboxes, poles, or other structures makes removal difficult. This includes fire hydrants and meters. Place debris at least 3 feet away from all obstacles.

WHITE GOODS/APPLIANCES

Washers/Dryers • Water Heaters

ROUTINE HOUSEHOLD WASTE

Routine household waste and bagged vegetative debris will not be picked up with disaster debris. You should continue to follow your normal waste collection schedule.

DO NOT BURN DEBRIS AND YARD WASTE. Burning storm debris is a violation of Jacksonville's year-round Burn Ban. Citizens can report this violation to 630-CITY(2489) by phone, or online at 630city.coj.net.
